


- X Abrasive cleaning creams or powders

What is Limescale?

If you live in a hard water area then there's every chance you are all too familiar with limescale.
What is Limescale?

Limescale is the deposits left behind by hard water.


Limescale is the chalky off-white crust that lurks inside your kettle and boiler and stains your surfaces.

Scientifically speaking limescale is a deposit of calcium carbonate and a residue left behind by hard water.

Hard water is water that contains a higher concentration of dissolved minerals like calcium and magnesium.

When the water evaporates, it leaves behind calcium carbonate deposits.

These limescale deposits therefore build up on any surfaces that hard water is in contact with and can accumulate quickly.



Apply easy care Limescale remover.



Rinse off with dish washing sponge and clean water.






Use washing-up liquid, dish washing sponge or eraser sponge and clean water.



Thoroughly wash the sink surface.



Rinse off with dish washing sponge and clean water.




Apply easy care Limescale remover.



Leave for 10 minutes.



Rinse off with dish washing sponge and clean water.



Insert plug and fill sink with 60° hot water to about 20 mm from bottom of the sink.




Leave for 1 & half hours.



Stir in 2-3 teaspoons of dish washing powder and thoroughly wash the sink surface.



Rinse off with dish washing sponge and clean water.




Completely dry off with an ordinary cleaning cloth and leave for 30 minutes before using the sink again for best results.




Apply easy care balsam to the sink surface ensuring all areas gets covered.



Leave for 1 minute.



Completely dry off with an ordinary cleaning cloth and leave for 6 hours before using the sink again for best results.






Use eraser sponge and clean water.




Rinse off with eraser sponge and clean water.






Use washing-up liquid, dish washing sponge or eraser sponge and clean water.

Rinse off with dish washing sponge and clean water.




Apply easy care Limescale remover.




Leave for 10 minutes.

Insert plug and fill sink with 30° hot water to about 20 mm from bottom of the sink.




Leave for 15 minutes.



Wear gloves, Stir in 30ml of easy care brightener and thoroughly wash the sink surface.



Rinse off with dish washing sponge and clean water.




Completely dry off with an ordinary cleaning cloth and leave for 30 minutes before using the sink again for best results.



Apply easy care balsam to the sink surface ensuring all areas gets covered.



Leave for 1 minute.



Completely dry off with an ordinary cleaning cloth and leave for 6 hours before using the sink again for best results.
